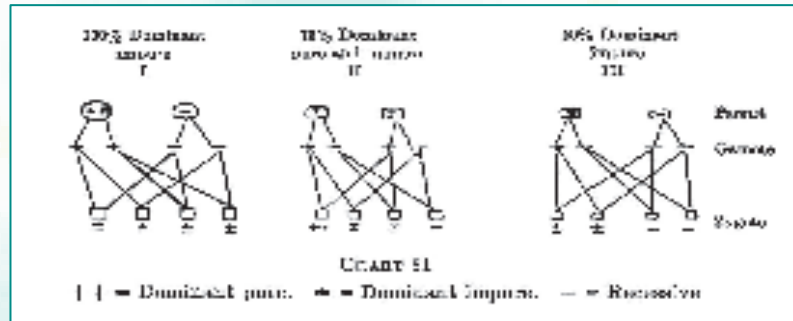


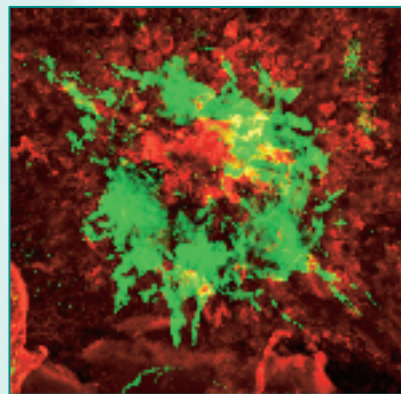

NIAID Pedigreed Rabbits Seeking New Homes

A largely closed colony of immunoglobulin allotype-defined rabbits, developed, bred, and characterized at the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID), NIH will be distributed to interested individuals, particularly to sites where breeding colonies can be established. They produce high affinity highly specific antibodies and those of b9 allotype have been used for selection of chimeric rabbit-human Fab for human diagnostic and therapeutic reagents. *More detailed information can be found at:*
